
Canatdora Overview

Cantadora translates to "Storyteller", founded by owner/winemaker, Kira Ballotta to share the stories of women giving back to our community in remarkable ways. Cantadora focuses on organically farmed, rich and opultent Rhone styles wines from Northern California Vineyards.

Each wine is made in partnership with the woman on the label so it is a reflection of their personality and unique story.

The Healer is dedicated to the story of Cynthia Tom. She is the founder A Place of Her Own, an arts based healing organization that aims to turn the heartache of generational trauma into resilience. She is third generation Chinese American, both her grandmother and father were trafficked into our country for differing purposes. Her artwork is in the permanent collection of the Smithsonian and her residency at San Francisco's De Young Museum addressing the stories of Asian American Families spurred her motivation to found A Place of Her Own.

Composition: 80% Mourvedre / 20% Syrah Vineyard: Shake Ridge Ranch, Amador County AVA. Farmed by the viticultural scion Ann Kraemer. She uses organic precision farming to produce, arguably, the highest quality wine grapes in the Sierra

Foothills. Alcohol: 14.3%

Co-Fermentation: This wine is a blend of one 100% Mourvedre fermentation an a Mourvedre/Syrah co-fermentation that achieves a silkier tannin expression than a traditional Mourvedre Elevage: 21mo in 100% nuetral French Oak barrels
